ASME EFX® events provide a forum for students and early career engineers to engage in technical programming, career and professional development sessions, competitions, social and networking activities and much more. EFX events range from ½ day to 2 days and typically take place on a weekend, depending on the host availability and the scope of the event.

Become an EFX Host

Universities, colleges, ASME Divisions/Sections throughout the world are invited to become an EFX Host! The ASME Program Management team will review and approve the EFX Application, based on the following criteria:

- Local resourcing to plan & support the EFX event
- University/Faculty/Industry support
- Modest budget for the event
- Target audience & expected size of the event
- Schedule of activities, such as, educational, technical, professional development sessions, ASME EFX Official or Impromptu competitions, networking activities, ASME-focused sessions, industry sponsorship opportunities, among others.
